ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE



To the residents and businesses of New Hope and Solebury:

Girls on the Run of Hunterdon, Bucks & Warren Counties will be holding its annual Girls on the Run Fall 5k Celebration on Saturday, November 19, 2022 within New Hope. In order to provide our race participants with the safest venue possible, certain borough streets will be closed during the event as deemed necessary by the New Hope and Solebury Police Departments. Listed below is an approximate timeline of road closures:

- **7:00-12:00pm:** No parking along Main Campus Drive behind New Hope-Solebury Upper Elementary School.
- **8:30-11:30am:** Main Campus Drive closed to vehicular traffic to West Bridge Street, down to the hill towards the Delaware River, turning left at the traffic light on to Route 32.
 - *Runners will run along Route 32 to the crossing point near Lower York Rd. Runners will then cross Route 32 and continue on to the Solebury Recreation Trail.*
 - *A water stop will be located along the recreation trail.*
 - *Runners will head back toward Main Campus Drive, making a left onto Hardy Bush Way for an out and back loop.*
 - *Finally, runners will turn left back onto Main Campus Drive and head toward the finish line back at the school near the tennis courts.*
- **9:00am:** 5K participants begin lining up on Main Campus Drive
- **9:30am:** 5K Race starts. All roads along the race route (Main Campus Drive to West Bridge Street, Route 32, Solebury Recreation Trail, Hardy Bush Way) are closed to vehicular traffic.
- **10:00-11:30am:** Roads along race route begin to reopen as deemed safe by the New Hope and Solebury Police Departments.
